

“Build Up”

Acts 9:31

Sermon Series: “Build Up, Build Out”

Introduction: Acts 9:31 says, “Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.”

We are going to look at these ideas of “edified” and “multiplied” the next two weeks and seek to apply them individually and corporately. “Edify” means “to build up” and refers to spiritual growth.

1. We need to be built up individually as followers of Jesus (Colossians 2:6-7, Jude 20-21).

6 “As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, 7 rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving.”

2. We need to build each other up corporately as the body of Christ (Ephesians 4:7-16).

How can we be spiritually built up individually and corporately?

- Salvation (John 1:10-13)
- Baptism (Acts 2:40-41)
- Time with God (Mark 1:35)
- Call the church to prayer (2 Chronicles 7:14)
- Church attendance (Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Small Groups (Acts 5:42)
- Generosity (Proverbs 3:9)
- Serving (1 Peter 4:10)
