

“What’s The Point Of Christmas?”
Colossians 1:19-23

Main Idea: Jesus is the God-Man who died for our sins in order to reconcile us to God and bring about our spiritual transformation.

1. Incarnation: Jesus is the God-Man in whom dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.

-Colossians 2:9

-Jesus, who is the Creator God, added humanity to His deity, and became part of the Creation (Colossians 1:15-17).

-Genesis 3:1-15

2. Reconciliation: Jesus died on the cross to bring us back to God (v.20).

-Colossians 1:14, 2:13-14

-He died to redeem the fallen creation, but in His death, He makes peace between repentant sinners and God by bringing us back together.

3. Transformation: The result of Him reconciling us through the cross is the complete transformation of our spiritual condition (v.21-23).

-He transforms us from being enemies who are alienated from God by our wicked works to being holy, blameless, and above reproach in the sight of God.
