Luke 5:27-39

Sermon Series: “The Servant King”

- 1. Jesus calls us to personally follow Him (v. 27-30).**
 - A. Jesus calls us to a personal relationship with Him (v.27).**
 - B. Jesus calls us to a new life in Him (v.28).**
 - C. Jesus calls us to a new mission for Him (v. 29-30).**
- 2. We must trust Jesus and repent in order to follow Him (v.28, 32).**
- 3. We must humble ourselves to follow Jesus because the self-righteous miss Him (v. 30-32).**

-Jesus came as a physician for the sick.

-The sick in this context are people who humble themselves and admit their sinfulness.

-It is about knowing Jesus and not religious rituals.

- 4. Following Jesus leads to a joyous new life (v. 33-39).**

- A. Following Jesus leads to joyous celebration (v. 33-35).**

-It's more like a feast than a fast.

- B. Following Jesus leads to experiencing the new covenant of grace instead of religious legalism (v. 36-39).**
